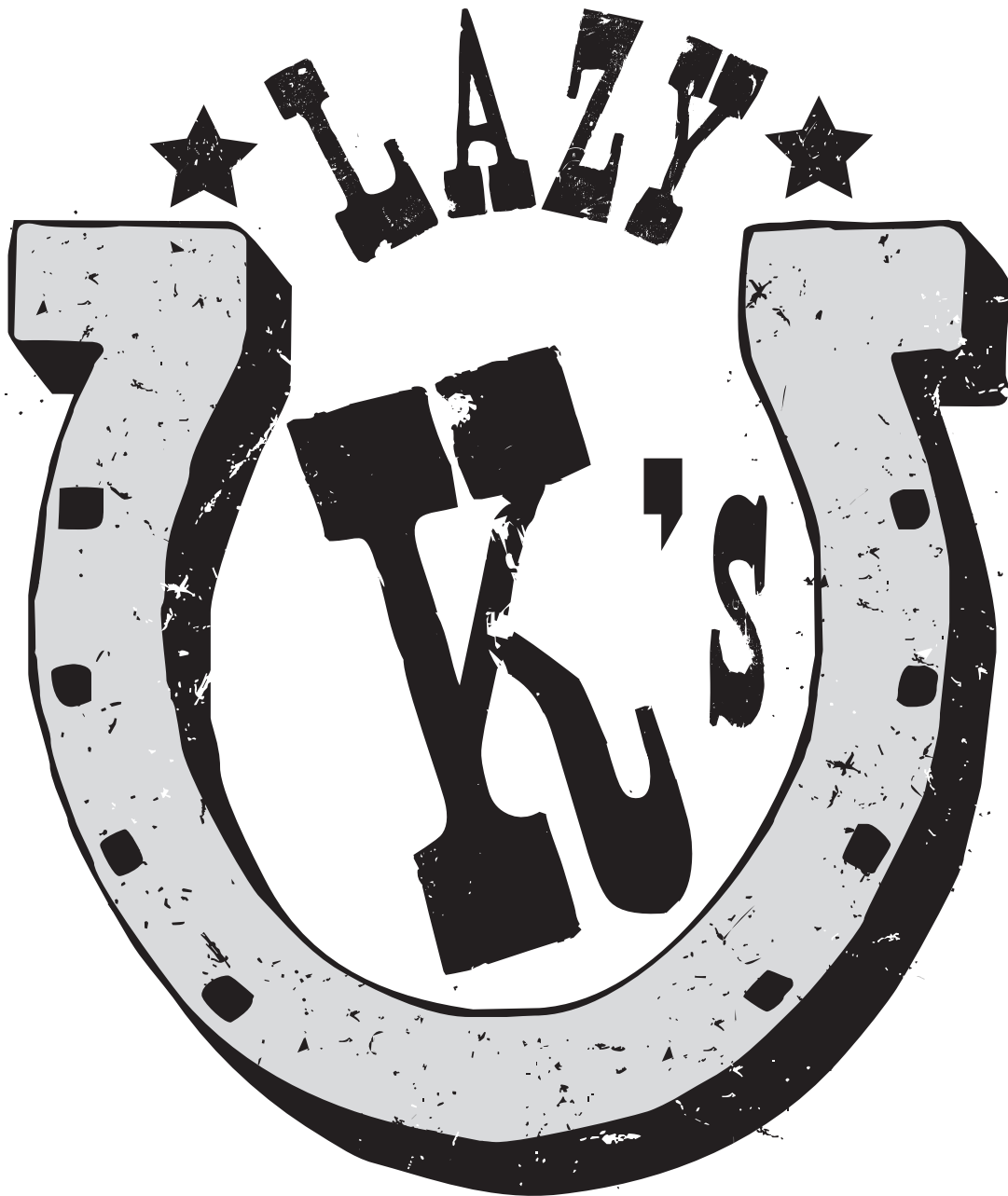

Harvest Salad – Celebrating the bounty with seasonal fruit, red onions, goat cheese, candied nuts and Raspberry Vinaigrette nestled in crispy greens - \$8.00

The Blues Chop Chop Salad – Crispy bacon and a hard boiled egg go toe-to-toe with romas, cucumbers, onions, gorgonzola, greens and Blue Cheese. Get down! - \$8.00
